Each year our Ride to Remember Horse Show tries to have a designated beneficiary. This year we are so thrilled to announce the shows the beneficiary is: Colonel Shawn Pederson.

Here is a short bio of Colonel Pederson. He is a 1990 U.S. Air Force Academy graduate who earned three additional advanced degrees and flew more than 400 combat hours that included missions in Bosnia, Iraq and Afghanistan.

He has served as a Strike Eagle pilot and Commander of the Black Panthers 494th Fighter Squadron at Lakenheath Air Base in England.

In 2002 he was the lead solo pilot for the Thunderbirds. This achievement fulfilled a lifelong dream for Colonel Pederson.

While working at the Pentagon in 2014 as an Asst Deputy Director to the Joint Staff, Colonel Pederson was diagnosed with a brain aneurysm. Knowing he would not fly again, he retired and was scheduled for surgery at Walter Reed, but the aneurysm ruptured 4 days before surgery. The rupture almost took his life. Colonel Pederson, a fighter, survived but was left severely disabled.

As part of his recovery regimen, Colonel Pederson wants to participate in Equine Therapy. Tri-State Therapeutic Riding Center works with individuals with many different disabilities in all walks of life.

Many of the disabled, like Colonel Pederson, need a special adaptive saddle that will stabilize their core and assist in maintaining an upright posture.

With your donations we are hoping to be able to help the Therapeutic Center purchase this saddle that is so needed by Colonel Pederson and other Veterans.

We also invite anyone that would like to come to center ring for the presentation of the donation.
